

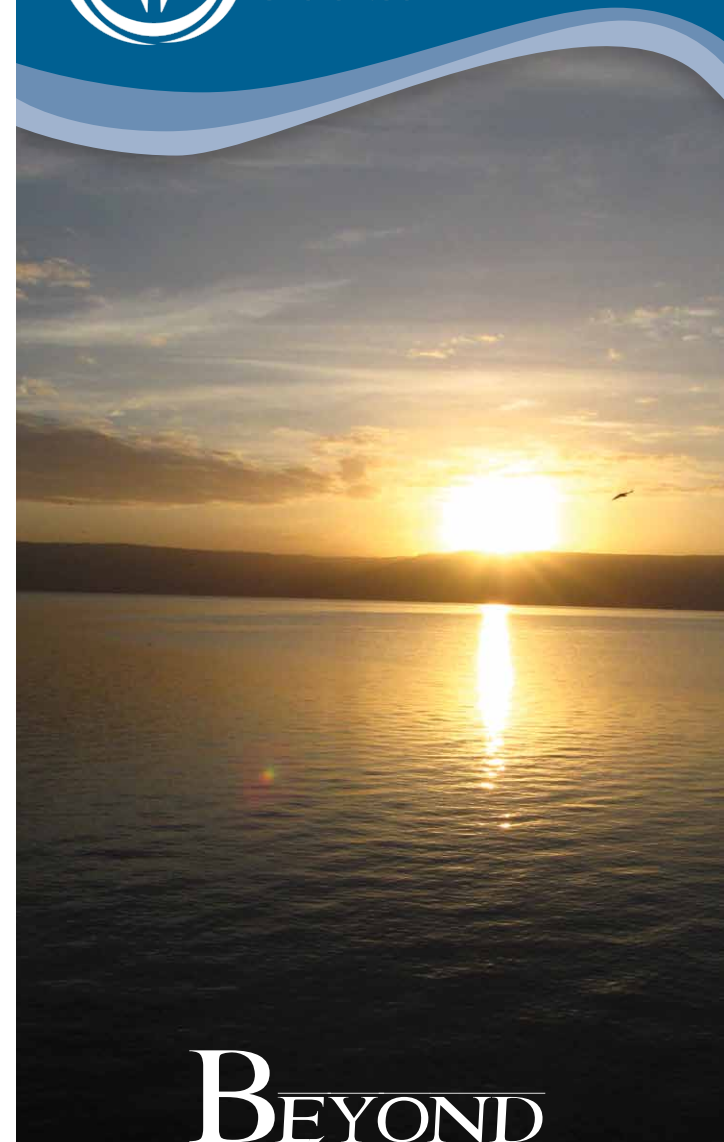
Construction of a new facility is a crucial step forward for Celebration Community Church, allowing us to grow and more efficiently fulfill our mission of making more and better disciples of Jesus Christ.

We have launched a Capital Stewardship Campaign entitled BEYOND to help us focus on God's future for our church, how a new facility fits into that picture, and what it will take to get there. Phase 1 of our new facility includes a finished 350-seat chapel, a finished building for children's classrooms and nursery space, a finished soccer field and parking lot, and two shelled buildings (exterior only) for future classroom and administrative space. The total cost of phase 1 is approximately \$2.3 million. Our prayer is that through the BEYOND campaign, members of Celebration Community Church will commit to 3-year pledges totaling at least \$500,000. We have a great challenge in front of us, but also an opportunity for profound joy and blessing. To help us gain a better understanding of the campaign, the following pages include some frequently asked questions and answers.

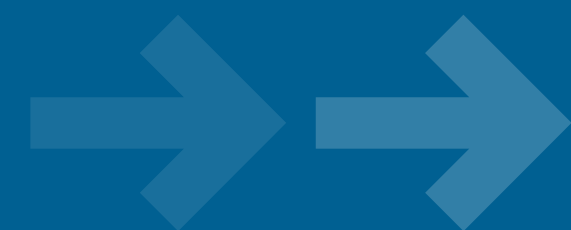

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What are we building?

We are building a brand new facility on our land that will include a multi-use chapel for worship, classroom and nursery space for our children, a full-size soccer field, and two other buildings for future expansion and administrative offices.

Why are we building it?

We believe that a facility will help us to more efficiently achieve our mission of making more and better disciples of Jesus Christ within the community of Celebration and the surrounding region. Besides providing us with a more permanent place to call home, we want to leverage our future facility for the sake of Gospel proclamation and the advancement of Christ's Kingdom.

When will we occupy the new facility?

Our hope is that we could be in our new facility sometime in the fall of 2011. We are aiming to finish the soccer field as soon as possible so that the community is able to use it.

How much will the new facility cost?

The projected price for phase 1 (completed chapel and children's space, soccer field, site work, and two shelled buildings) is approximately \$2.3 million.

How will we pay for it?

The cost of much of the planning and design phase has already been met through our existing building fund and other gifts. The balance will be borrowed from a bank and paid off through a combination of donations and pledges made through the "Beyond" Capital Stewardship Campaign and funds allotted in our church's budget.

How much money are we hoping to raise through the "Beyond" campaign?

Our goal is to raise at least \$500,000, which is two times our annual operating budget. This amount would be made up of upfront cash gifts and/or three-year pledges.

Will I be pressured to make a pledge?

No. Participation in the campaign and how much you give is entirely up to you. However, we do encourage everyone at CCC to consider giving sacrificially to "Beyond" above their regular giving or tithe. While we do not expect equal gifts from everyone, the Bible does call us to equal generosity and equal sacrifice when it comes to giving toward God's mission in the world.

How long will my commitment be?

You are asked to make a 3-year commitment.

If I can't give a large amount, does my pledge really matter?

Absolutely! All pledges matter, regardless of amount, because as we all participate according to our ability, God multiplies our giving.

When are we expected to give the amount pledged?

Pledge cards will be turned in on Commitment Sunday (March 6, 2011), and pledges will begin to be received shortly thereafter.

What forms of contributions will be accepted?

Contributions can be made via cash, check, and online transaction. Other forms of contributions can include the transference of title to marketable stocks, bonds, real estate, ETF's, etc.

May I update my commitment after Celebration Sunday?

Yes. You may update your commitment or pledge at any time.

Do you have to be a Covenant Partner at CCC to participate in the campaign?

No. Anyone is welcome to give to the "Beyond" campaign and share in its joy!
